## CHAT English Club - going from strength to strength!

Our weekly conversation club run by coordinator Mandy offers a warm welcome to any non-native speakers and a team of dedicated and talented volunteers offer support tailored to the students' individual needs. We have students from countries as diverse as Iran, Congo and Vietnam; 41 different students have attended since September and numbers are increasing week on week. Mandy has developed creative and innovative ways of addressing the needs of a wide variety of learners and the group is planning a spring trip in the next month.

## CHAT Phoenix House - exciting new developments.

Since October we have provided 857 cups of tea to those using the Tribunal and offered a friendly face and listening ear to over 100 asylum seekers. The tribunal is busier than ever and our volunteers are there between 2 and 3 days a week to offer support at a time which can be bewildering and distressing. We are very pleased to have appointed a new CHAT Phoenix House Coordinator who will start in April - they come with a wealth of experience supporting asylum seekers and refugees in West Yorkshire and we look forward to them joining our team. Huge thanks must go to Heather our trustee who has looked after the project for almost a year.



### The Hosting Project

We are thrilled to have recently recruited a new hosting household and therefore able to increase our capacity of being able to offer accommodation to vulnerable destitute asylum seekers.

### McKenzie Friends

Our team of 16 volunteers are currently supporting 28 asylum seekers and one client we helped to find legal representation recently had their appeal allowed. In the last months we have received some excellent training from local lawyers and have developed a handbook for new and existing volunteers to offer more guidance and support - specifically on the difference between giving advice and information. This is a resource developed with the help of a local lawyer and Right to Remain whose Toolkit is invaluable for our work.
